As winter moves towards Spring we take hope from the appearance of snowdrops, and Helebores. Tiny miniature daffodil heads encourage us to look at the sunshine in our lives and be thankful.

God shows Himself and His promise of New Life in the natural world, and fills us with encouragement.

75 years have elapsed since the great Snow of 1947, when Onecote and remote Moorland villages were cut off by enormous snowdrifts.

On Sunday, February 13th, a thanksgiving service took place (75yrs to the day) for eight brave men who lost their lives bringing supplies to Moorland hamlets. The wing tip of their Halifax bomber touched Grindon Moor and tragically crashed.

An RAF fly past was arranged, weather permitting to honour these Snow Drop Heroes. The Lord Lieutenant and representatives of 49th Squadron the RAF Association, RAF Cadets and appreciative local residents were in attendance in Grindon Church.

So we give thanks for out lives and those who help protect us and are grateful.

Services are held at Onecote Chapel on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month. All are welcome.
